The second visit of the season to Norfolk for 750 Motor Club brings with it another huge timetable of racing action, featuring no fewer than 11 formulae and a total of 21 races.

The CALM All Porsche Trophy Series fields an impressive entry, with racing that encompasses both a pair of 20-minute sprint races, plus a longer 40-minute mini-enduro on Sunday. Last time out here at Snetterton, the SP1 battle between James Coleman and Warren Allen was the show of the field in their Caymans; but with neither driver on track this weekend both SP1 and the three other busy classes are wide open for silverware to be claimed on a grid that features everything from Stuart Jefcoate's 993 to Boxsters, 924s, 968 Club Sports and the Wright duo's 944 Turbo.

There is also endurance action on Sunday from the huge GAZ Shocks 116 Trophy Series, where around 40 cars are set to contest the 90-minute affair with mandatory pitstops. Victory last time out at Anglesey went the way of Mack Priestwood – his third of the season so far – but this event sees the return of Matthew Highcock after sitting out Anglesey; the only other driver to stand on the top step so far this year. Before that, many of those drivers will contest Saturday's 116 Sprint races where there is also a championship at stake and Priestwood at the top of the table. Just one single point separates him from Highcock though, with Will Abraham next in line. The sprint races also showcase the new 120 Coupe Cup alongside; with Alan Corfield joining the lineup this weekend.

Defending champion Jonathan Candler currently tops the championship points in the Armed Forces Race Challenge; the Peugeot 306 driver fending off Phil England (Impreza) in second place and Mark White (Civic) third in this formula that rewards consistency as well as outright pace. Steve Schweikhardt is another 2023 champion who has made a great start to his title defence this season; topping the overall BMW Car Club Championship table as well as in Class 6, but he's being chased by a trio of frontrunners from the affordable Cup Class for E46 325ti Compacts where William Lake just holds the edge over Gareth Thomas.

Other one-make tin-top action comes from the K-Tec Racing Clio Sport Championship, where former Club 100 karter Peter O'Connor is flying high in Class A; following a pair of second-place finishes at the Brands Hatch opener he has remained unbeaten. He holds an overall 13-point margin back to Class B leader Justin Griffiths; with the ever-improving Darren Ransom close behind after finishing six out of seven races so far this season on the class podium.

For the Japanese car fans, things are similarly close in the Tegiwa Type R Trophy Championship, where four victories to three sees Matt Wilkins just have the edge over defending champion Joe Jessup as we go into the second half of the season. Jessup claimed three podiums from three on the formula's last visit here in 2022 though, and as the last triple-header of the season, points here will be vital for both ahead of Croft and the Silverstone finale.

Just two points separates Locost graduate David Hitchin from formula stalwart Ben Powney in the Aim Shop Ma7da Championship, as former Locost champions Craig Land and Martin West sit close behind. It was Eddie Mawer who claimed two wins from two last time here in Norfolk, whilst fending off the approaches of Jonathan Lisseter – the two time-Ma7da champion who we are set to make his Nankang Tyre Sports 1000 Championship debut this weekend in a Mittell MC-53.

Multiple former champion Ryan Yarrow looks well on his way to adding another title to his tally in his Spire, but it is mighty close behind in the points between Carl Austen, Paul Rogers, Colin Chapman and Charlie Sladden. This meeting also bring a great entry for the burgeoning Cup 200 class – look out for F1000 frontrunner Dan Gore on his debut in the exciting new MK sportscar.

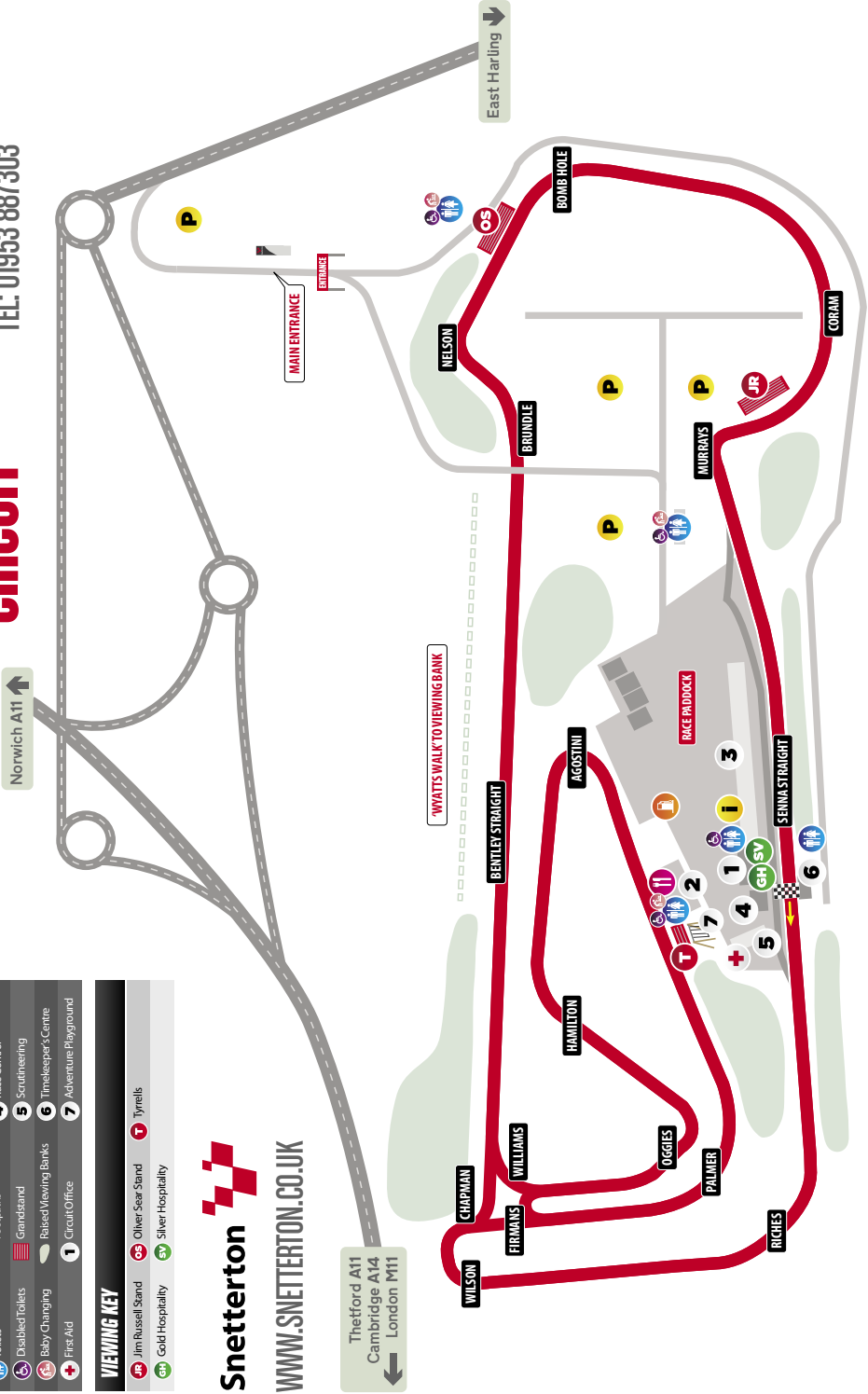

FLAG SIGNALS

BLUE/STEADY

Another competitor is close.

BLUE/WAVED

Another competitor is trying to pass.

WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

YELLOW(WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

YELLOW(DOUBLEWAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking.

YELLOW/RED.STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

GREEN

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap.

RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by Marshals (at startline & individual Marshal's posts). Race Stopped.

BLACK/ORANGE.DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to driver that his behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of Course.



GET INVOLVED AT THE SHARP END OF MOTORSPORT

As an active alternative to competing, you could become one of the hundreds of hardy souls who clad themselves in orange overalls each weekend, to carry out the variety of jobs essential to the safe running of an event. It's a serious undertaking and can get you very close to the action at times - writes Peter Harding

Course, Incident, Flag, Post Chief, Pits, Paddock, Assembly, Telephone, Race Rescue Unit etc. - all these basically come under the umbrella of marshaling. However, you don't just come along and do whatever job you fancy on the day; there is a lot more to it than that. Those with no experience start as Trainees and will be placed with experienced marshals at whatever position they are allocated. Training days are available, ranging from fire-fighting, incident handling, use and knowledge of the many flags through to, after years of experience, becoming Examining Post Chief or Specialist.

The 750 Motor Club looks after its Marshals, realising only too well that they are all volunteers and

it has a Sponsorship Scheme to assist new marshals to buy the necessary kit (overalls, wet weather gear etc) or to help with their replacement; this funding uniquely comes directly from the 750 Motor Club competitors by way of donations to our Marshals Fund.

With its many race days the 750 Motor Club has lots to offer to both new and experienced Marshals.
