## PRE- EVENT:

All additional drivers, passengers and instructors will need to complete the online check in using the closed wheel link above. ## VENUE ACCESS:


If anyone who is either unable to attend at the last minute or has a terminal issue during the day, could please come and let us know they are withdrawing regardless of what time it would be appreciated.
