PRE- EVENT:

All additional drivers, passengers and instructors will need to complete the online check in using the closed wheel link above. In addition to completing the relevant online form, ALL participants will be required to watch an online briefing which will be available from 8am on Saturday the 7th of March.

VENUE ACCESS:

Access to the venue will be from 18:00 on Saturday the 7th of March, any teams/drivers arriving prior to this time must park in accordance with the advice of the venue security.

WRISTBAND COLLECTION / LICENCE PRESENTATION:

Wristband and Car Sticker collection will be available from 07:30 in the Garage 39 Reception in the centre of the paddock. You must present your driving licence and collect your wristband before being allowed on to the track (Single Seater / Sports Racing drivers and those Under 18's without a full driving licence MUST be in possession of a current 2026 MSUK race licence.)


If anyone who is either unable to attend at the last minute or has a terminal issue during the day, could please come and let us know they are withdrawing regardless of what time it would be appreciated.
