



TESTING INSTRUCTIONS

Pre-Event:

Please ensure that you complete the attached Test Day Registration Form and send it to iajn@750mc.co.uk before 9am on Thursday the 9th of April. Additional Drivers and any Instructors are also required to complete the Registration Form.

Venue Access:

Access to the venue will be from 1pm until 10.30pm on Thursday the 9th April. Please park in the area of paddock that you have been allocated for the Race Meeting (see [here](#) for details.) A vehicle pass will have been issued via email to each competitor. This pass will need to be scanned on arrival and once done, a physical paper vehicle pass will be issued. All other vehicles will need to be parked in the public car park.

Timetable / Wristband Collection:

Wristbands and Group Stickers for the car will be available for collection from 07:30 in the Whitely Room on the ground floor of the race control building. You must show your race license to the 750MC staff then collect your wristband and apply the group sticker to your vehicle prior to taking to the track.

Noise Testing:

Drivers must be go to the assembly area for noise testing in advance of to the circuit for their first session.

Track Limits:

During the test day, the circuit will be operating a "sin bin" policy for those who consistently ignore track limits. Marshals will report drivers who have been off track twice, drivers will subsequently be shown the black flag upon which they must enter the pitlane where an official will advise them of where they are breaking track limits. Should that driver then continue to ignore track limits they will be shown the black flag again where they will be brought back into the pitlane and held in a designated area for 10 minutes.

GENERAL TEST – REGULATIONS 2026

All test participants should note the following simple Regulations.

1. No insurance cover is provided by 750 Motor Club or Croft Circuit for your vehicle.
2. You will not be allowed onto the track to test unless you have signed on in advance.
3. Driver/s must possess a current valid MOTORSPORT UK or FIA-ASN sanctioned Competition Race Licence.
4. No passengers are permitted on General Test days (except Instructors - see Rule 4a)
- 4a – Instructors* are permitted to sit alongside the Signed-on driver. *Such Instructors must have a valid current ARDS Licence. Instructors are given a different colored wristband when they sign on to identify them as an Instructor.
5. All Driver/s must wear FULL race clothing, including FIA-approved race suits and helmets.
6. All drivers must complete and sign the standard 750MC Test Day Indemnity Form.
7. Any driver who is considered by 750MC or circuit staff to be driving or behaving dangerously or inappropriately at any time, will be asked to leave the circuit immediately, without any refund of their test fee.
8. Note there will be mixed classes/formulas and in some sessions open and closed wheel cars all on track together.
9. Please be aware there may be less experienced drivers on track with Instructors.
10. MOTORSPORT UK noise limits of 105/108 dbA will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave the circuit if you are found to be over the noise limit.
11. The consumption of alcohol or drugs by any Test Day participant is strictly prohibited. By signing on you agree that you may be tested for alcohol or drugs at any time.
12. Please drive with consideration towards your fellow drivers at all times as some vehicles of different types and/or of different ages, will take different lines to your own.
13. Flag/Light signaling System is in operation:

Black SLOW DOWN, leave circuit, report to race control.
Red Flag/Light SLOW DOWN, session stopped, do not overtake. Leave the circuit where directed.
Yellow Flag /Light Flashing Extreme caution, hazard ahead do not overtake.
Checkered End of session, proceed to exit.
Yellow/Red Stripes Slippery conditions water/oil/fuel proceed with care
14. Note that no animals are permitted on site.
15. Paddock gates will open from 1pm on Thursday the 9th April.
